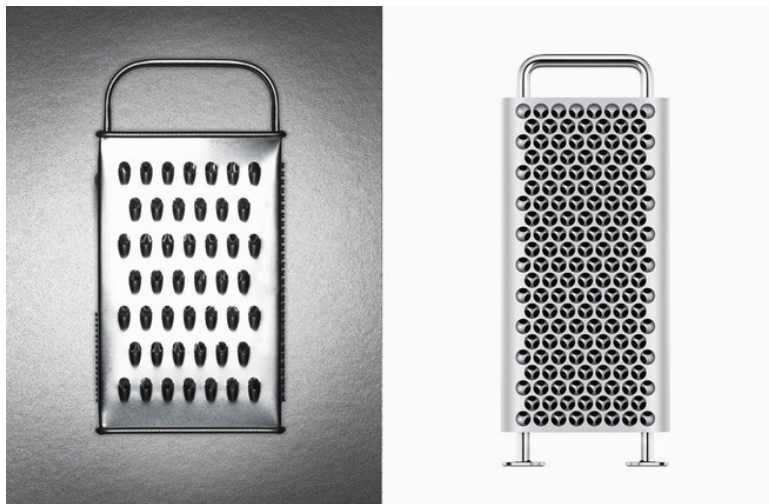


YouTuber test uses a Mac Pro heat sink for \$ 6000 to make a cheese shaver and an end

YouTuber Winston Moy conducted a funny test on the Mac Pro to test this.



The cheese shavings (left) and the grille of the new Mac Pro cost \$ 6000.

Since Apple's new Mac Pro hasn't been officially sold yet, he had to rebuild the 3D design of that grille, machining it on a CNC machine. After that, he used it to test the cheese. Unfortunately, this simulation grid cannot make delicious cheeses. This means that the heat dissipation of the Mac Pro is also the same, it is designed to help release air, not to . cheese.

However, Moy's video also shows us that the design of the Mac Pro requires very high accuracy.
